**Book Report #2:** The Old Man and the Sea by Earnest Hemingway

## **Assignment for Book Two:**

- In *The Old Man and the Sea*, Ernest Hemingway presents a deceptively simple story of an old fisherman's struggle to catch a great marlin, but beneath the surface lies a profound exploration of human endurance, dignity, and the relationship between man and nature. For your essay, write a **three-page** literary analysis responding to the following:
- **Prompt:** Discuss how Ernest Hemingway uses the character of Santiago to explore the themes of **perseverance**, **isolation**, **and the indomitable human spirit**. How do these themes shape Santiago's identity and influence his relationship with the sea, the marlin, and the boy, Manolin?

## Your essay should:

- Offer a clear, original **thesis statement** that connects Santiago's personal struggle with the broader human experience.
- Provide **textual evidence** (specific quotes and scenes) to support your analysis of Santiago's perseverance, emotional or physical isolation, and resilience.
- Explore how Hemingway's **writing style** (such as sentence structure, imagery, or symbolism) contributes to the depth of these themes.
- Consider **counterarguments** or complexities—e.g., Is Santiago truly alone? Does his struggle represent failure, success, or something in between?
- Conclude with a reflection on what Hemingway may be suggesting about the value of struggle, even when defeat seems inevitable.
