School Safety and Security Recommendations

The Committee feels that using the School Safety Grant money to provide fencing at the front of the school with the use of swipe/keypad entry will be a positive move in the right direction for the school. Also discussed were the numerous windows that are on the exterior entrance doors to classrooms. We will look at getting those priced to see if a shatter resistant tint or replacing the doors will be the best option for the school - both financially and for safety purposes. We are still waiting for the swipe card entries for the side doors, bus camera updates, and school camera updates, but due to availability, we still do not have these items in place.

Staff Attendance Incentives

The Committee feels that providing gift card rewards for staff that has demonstrated perfect attendance for the first semester will be a good idea to make sure we recognize those staff members who have been to work each and every day.

Teacher Feedback Form Information

The teacher feedback form that was sent out yielded many different responses. The leadership team is working on addressing the different responses from the staff. The main items were staff attendance, staff volunteering, vertical alignment, lunch menus/shortages, parent and community involvement, school pride. We are tying these items back to the School Improvement Plan to create plans to resolve some of the issues at hand.

Schoolwide Initiative for Independent Learners

We are still working on getting a plan together for the teachers to understand the importance of them modeling independence in the classroom - changing their mindset - to get students to become more independent learners.
