Dear Dawson Springs School Family and Stakeholders,

As I am writing this message, we are now in our 16th day of school. To this point, many things have gone exceptionally well. By all appearances, our students and staff are very happy to be back fully in-person. We have seen immediate, accelerated learning in many areas, which we attribute to being back together full time.

We believe and, as we've proven repeatedly, our students learn at much higher levels when we're together and we can engage and interact face-to-face. Our goal is to continue our current protocols until things recede some and we can ease them. Much of the legal flexibility we had last year to utilize NTI/emergency days or virtual/remote days are not an option this year. We do have limited NTI days to utilize (10), but we are hopeful the legislature will take action soon to restore some of the more extensive emergency flexibility we had last school year should we need that.

As I've stated multiple times before, we can continue in-person learning so long as we only have a "handful" of staff quarantines or positive Covid19 cases. Too many cases would put us into a situation where we simply wouldn't have the number of staff required to safely conduct and supervise classes. You may have seen or read where some school districts across the state have had to close for a week or two or go virtual because they simply did not have enough staff healthy to keep their schools going.

As Covid19 and the Delta variant continues to rage, I encourage everyone age 12 and above to get vaccinated if you haven't already. Data from various health professionals seem to show that, while vaccination may not make someone totally immune from catching Covid19, it does minimize the risk for significant illness or even worse. In many reports, the overwhelming majority of those in intensive care in hospitals appear to be unvaccinated individuals. Vaccination is free and can be gotten quickly at the Hopkins County Health Department. They can be reached at 270-821-5242 for more information and to set up an appointment. I encourage you to utilize these resources.

I am aware a few may not agree with some of our current protocols. I do believe that our protocols have worked to help us stay in school up to this point. As an example, Warren Courty Schools in Bowling Green started the school year in early August with "masks optional." In the first three days of school, they had well over 1,000 quarantines and a significant number of positive student and staff Covid19 cases. They quickly changed course and required face coverings. At that point, their numbers started to go on the decline.

Covid19 continues to be a battle that many of us have not seen in our lifetime. We do have backup emergency plans should we need to go back fully virtual/remote, but we are hopeful to not have to go in that direction. We continue to be committed to serving our students the absolute best that we can. Our students love being in school, and we love them being here. I cannot commend our students and staff enough as they continue to rise to the occasion as challenges come up. We appreciate your continued support as we try to do all we can to stay safe and stay in school.


