Family will

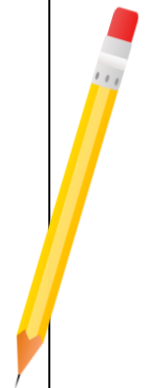
Attend "BRIGHT Nights" and use the math and reading strategies to help support their child's learning.

- Review comprehension assignments and strategies with your child to increase fluency and vocabulary, subject areas and reads nightly for 30 minutes Monday – Thursday.
- Review student's work in Tuesday folders as well as Google Classroom.

Student will
