
#### New Milford Public Schools Mission Statement and Ideas We Live By

#### OVER 200 ACRES WITH 9 BALL DIAMONDS AND MULTIPLE FIELDS INCLUDING 2 TURF


























#### **Budgeting for ESC BMS Contract**

- New HVAC equipment as part of the ESG energy conservation project are controlled by a separate building automation system (BMS).
- There is an annual preventive maintenance contract associated with ESC for their services.



#### **Budgeting for Maintenance of McCarthy Observatory**



- A 2005 MOU states that the physical maintenance of the observatory falls within the purview of the Board of Education.
- Facilities wants to acknowledge that responsibility by creating a specific observatory maintenance account.



#### **Budgeting for Annual Fire Hydrant Inspections**



- In the past annual fire hydrant inspections were conducted by the water company.
- Some of the hydrants on school property have been identified as private and are the property owners responsibility to inspect and maintain.



## **Overview of Budget Drivers**

• REPAIR/BUILDING line for schools increases an average of 2%, for a total of \$8,200. This is to cover costs of performing annual fire hydrant inspections district wide and the new preventive maintenance contract for ESC building management.

• New Accounts for McCarthy Observatory preventive maintenance and repairs total \$5,000.

• CUSTODIAL SUPPLIES line increases 2%, for a total of \$3,800. This is to cover additional material for ball diamonds in district .
