




From the Alumnae Association

AP English Class Meets Fr. Boyle


The St. Mary's Academy 2013 summer reading book for AP English was *Tattoos on the Heart: The Power of Boundless Compassion*. The book is a collection of true stories by Fr. Gregory Boyle, who founded Homeboy Industries in 1992 to help former gang members take their lives in a better direction.

On Tuesday, September 17, 2013, SMA students joined Loyola Marymount University students in a panel discussion about the book as well as about the challenges of starting college. This was followed by a university-wide event with Fr. Boyle, who shared many

experiences and anecdotes about the founding of

Homeboy Industries and those lives it touched. Two of the "homeboys," young former gang members, also spoke at the event. They were extremely grateful for the chance to make such drastic improvements to their lives, and it was moving and inspiring to hear their stories. Afterwards, students had the opportunity to speak with Fr. Boyle and his "homeboys." Fr. Boyle signed the AP class copy of *Tattoos on the Heart*, and students took a picture with one of the "homeboys" (see above).

Belles who attended the event said it was an amazing experience, and they will maintain their inspiration and drive to help others as they continue their lives and community service with compassion and kinship.
