# Academic Progress from State Testing - Information Item

SGSC currently serves 14 different counties: Calhoun, Chattahoochee, Clay, Dougherty, Early, Lee, Marion, Quitman, Randolph, Schley, Stewart, Sumter, Terrell, and Webster. Of those 14 different counties - SGSC outperformed all but Lee and Schley County in the area of content mastery in elementary, middle, and high school. Chattahoochee County Elementary did outperform the elementary in the area of content mastery. We are very excited to see this analysis and how well the teachers and students performed on the Milestones assessments.
