Helpful Hints

- -Digraphs are two consonants that stand together but make only one consonant sound. The digraphs are ch, ph, sh, th, wh
- -The suffix -ed has three sounds. The sound of the consonant that immediately precedes -ed determines the correct pronunciation of the suffix.
 - -Following the letters f, k, p, s, and x, the sound of the suffix is /t/
 - -Following the letters =n, m, b, g, v, l, z, and vowels, the sound of the suffix is $\mbox{\sc d}/\mbox{\sc d}/\mbox{\sc d}$
 - -Following t or d, the sound of -ed is id/
