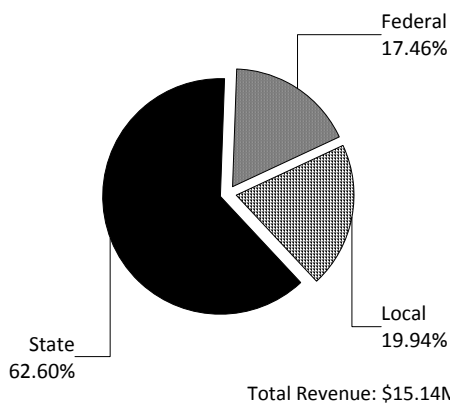

Revenue Sources



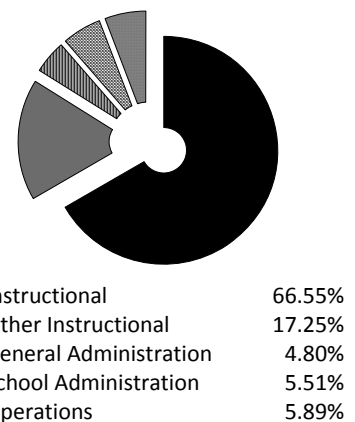
