HOMEWORK

Homework Logs are due on Tuesdays. These packets will have a chart to keep track of days that you and your child read/do homework for 20 minutes. You only need to return the front page each week.

CLASSWORK

As you look at your student's work you will sometimes see that it is incomplete. During class we don't always have time to finish everything. If you would like your child to finish the work at home for practice that is great but they do not have to. If there is a required piece of homework, I will write "homework" in a bright color at the top.

SIGHT WORDS

You will receive a sight word packet and book for your child. Please have your child cut out one page of words at a time and go through them until they know them just by looking at them. You can check it off on the tracking sheet as they go through.

LIBRARY

Each week we have library time on Friday. Please have your child bring their books back each week to check out new books. If you're not finished with the book you are welcome to keep it another week and return it the next. Your child can only have two books checked out at one time. One that is around their reading level and one "choice" book.

SPELLING

Please take time to practice the words in the SuperKids homework packet at home and talk with your child about the "rules" the words follow.

STANDARDS

Reading/Writing

- Identify and say the beginning, middle, and ending sounds in a spoken, one-syllable word.
- Hears and shows each sound in a word. Orally segments a word, using manipulatives to mark each phoneme when given a single-syllable word.
- Blends sounds to say a one syllable word.
- Identified digraphs in words and can say, read, and spell the digraphs correctly.

Math

- Can compare two whole numbers 0-200, using greater than (>), less than (<), or equal to (=).
- Order three numbers from 0-200, from least to greatest and greatest to least.
- Identify and write any whole number from 0-200.
- Count by 1's, 2's, and 10's to 120 starting from any number less than 100.

Science

- Identify seasonal weather patterns.
- Identifying patterns that happen in space.

Social Studies

- Understand that we all belong in groups and places.
- Understanding the difference between the past, present and future.

THINGS TO KNOW:

School Drop Off/Pickup: School drop off and pick up is at the front of the building. For safety reasons, please do not drop off/pick up students in the back of the school where the busses are.

After school plans: If your child's after school plan is different from what they usually do, you must notify the school. Your student will then get a yellow note which lets staff know that they are to do something different.
