

Uniform Expectations

We believe as a school that how we feel about ourselves is influenced by what we wear. Adhering to uniform expectation develops a strong sense of community and school pride. Use the rule of good judgment. If you have to consider whether it's appropriate, then you probably should <u>not</u> wear it.



Student ID's Must be Worn & Visible at All Times

General Dress (Monday-Thursday)

• Shirts:

- Black/Orange/White LWHS polo at all times; even under approved jackets/hoodies
- Shirts must be tucked in at all times
- T-shirts/turtlenecks worn under the uniform polo shirt must be plain black, gray, orange, or white

• Pants/Shorts:

- Must be khaki pants or Khaki Bermuda length shorts (and worn at waist)
- · No Skirts or Skorts
- All pants & shorts must be hemmed (free from frays, holes, rips, or tears)

• Shoes:

- Tennis Shoes, TOMS, Crocs, sandals, and slides (NO FLUFFY SLIDES or BEDROOM SLIPPERS)
- Small/modest jewelry & small necklaces are acceptable
- No medallions larger than 3 inches in diameter

Friday Attire

- Same as General Dress Day with following exceptions:
 - LWHS approved T-shirts (clubs, athletics, career academies, state tournaments, etc.)
 - · College Shirts
 - Blue or black jeans/Bermuda length shorts (free from frays, holes, rips, or tears)
 - Shirts may be untucked on Fridays
- College Jackets/Hoodies are NOT acceptable

Senior Dress Code Privileges

- Same as General Dress Day with following exceptions:
- Seniors may wear Blue or Black jeans Monday through Friday! (Jeans must be free from frays, holes, rips, & tears)
- · Herff Jones Senior hoodie
- IB Crew Sweatshirt or Long Sleeve

Game Day Attire

• Team Shirt/Jersey must be tucked in - if sleeveless, must have shirt under jersey (black/grey/ orange/white)

Outerwear

- You Are Your Brother's Keeper Hoodie is the *only* approved hoodie for LWHS
- · Any approved LWHS jacket without a hood

Winter Dress

Only when announced by LWHS via callout system, LWHS social media account, or Schoology post.

- Same as General Dress Day with following exceptions:
 - Jeans are permitted for all grade levels (free from frays, holes, rips, or tears)
 - Any school appropriate hoodie/jacket/sweater may be worn
- NO leggings, pajamas, sweatpants, yoga pants, bedroom slippers
- NO Blankets

Dress Down Days

Only when announced by LWHS via callout system, LWHS social media account, or Schoology post.

School appropriate attire is still required, <u>none</u> of the following are permitted:

- Spaghetti straps
- Holes, rips, or tears in jeans
- Exposed midriffs
- Leggings, pajamas, sweatpants, yoga pants, bedroom slippers
- Visible undergarments
- Attire advertising any alcohol/drugs/sex
- All shorts & dresses must be bermuda length for all students
- All pants/jeans must be worn at the waist.

Miscellaneous

- Clothing purchased from a sports team fundraiser must follow our uniform policy if you wish to wear it at school; no hoodies and items must be school colors (black/grey/orange/white) in order to wear on campus.
- No hats, wave caps, do-rags, bandanas, or other distracting head coverings
- Pierced ears with moderate jewelry that does not present a hazard
- Nose piercing with a small stud or small hoop only (no bull nose rings)
- · Blankets are NOT permitted
- If a student repeatedly refuses to adhere to uniform expectations it may result in suspension or referral back to his/her zoned school.
- School administration will determine if clothing complies with LWHS expectation
