- Report on Covid Cases - - 0 cases since last meeting
- AEDs- - Andrea Brown
  - We are purchasing the Heartsine Samaritan. It is very small, lightweight & simple to use.
  - o The Police Chief will also be carrying one in his police vehicle.
  - o This will bring our total AED number to 17. We are keeping 1 of our older ones because it was purchased in 2018. We will replace it at a later date.
  - Our vendor notified me that we may not receive them until the end of the school year due to issues with the FDA and customs.
- Narcan- - Andrea
  - o An new local policy was passed, so this will be implemented for next school year
  - Cost is between \$45-\$65 for a 2 dose box. Would need to order 1 box for each campus and 1 for the SRO and 1 for the trainer (6 total for a total of \$270-\$455).
  - o Need to add this information to the student handbook for next year
  - Would train employees on when and how to administer Narcan. This will be done
    at the same time with yearly CPR like we do with EpiPens.
  - oWould have a standard in place instructing staff on when and how to administer
  - oWill work on a written standard and an addition to the student handbook for next vear
  - oWill add this to our standing orders for next year
- Looking at getting the LifeVac Anti Choking device (choking plunger) for our emergency kits
  - Would like to purchase 20 of these.
  - Cost is \$240 per kit of 4 (approximately \$1,200 for 20)
  - oWaiting on a quote from Life Vac to see what kind of deal they can give us
- 180 Degree Education:
  - Secondary counselors would like to use the 180 degree curriculum from Denton for Teen Dating Violence education. Catherine Kelly gave us a brief overview of the program.
