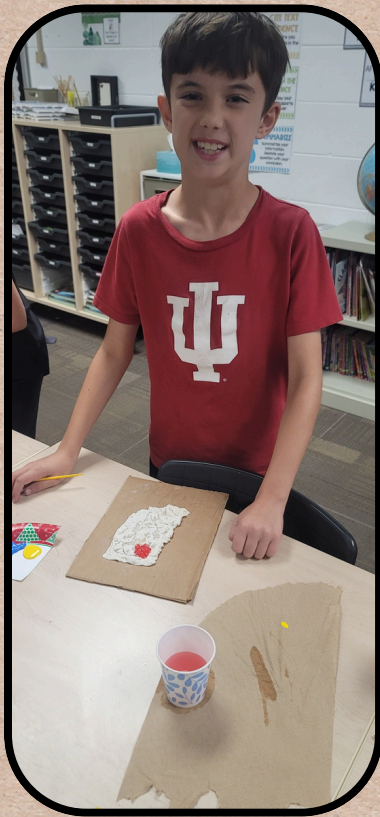
2024 Scarecrow Stampede 5k run/3k walk

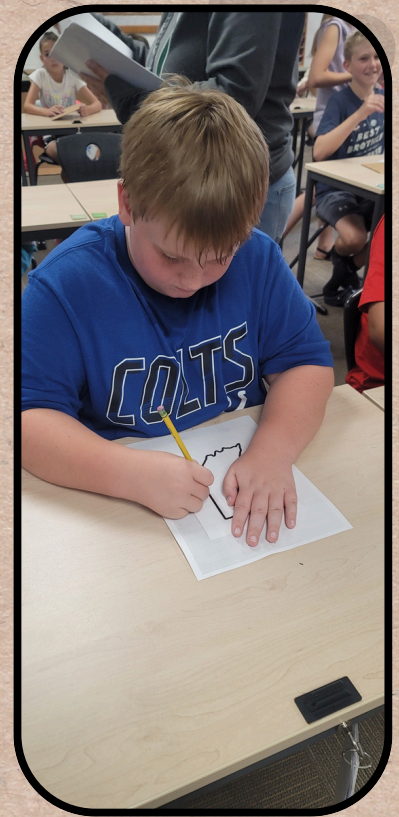

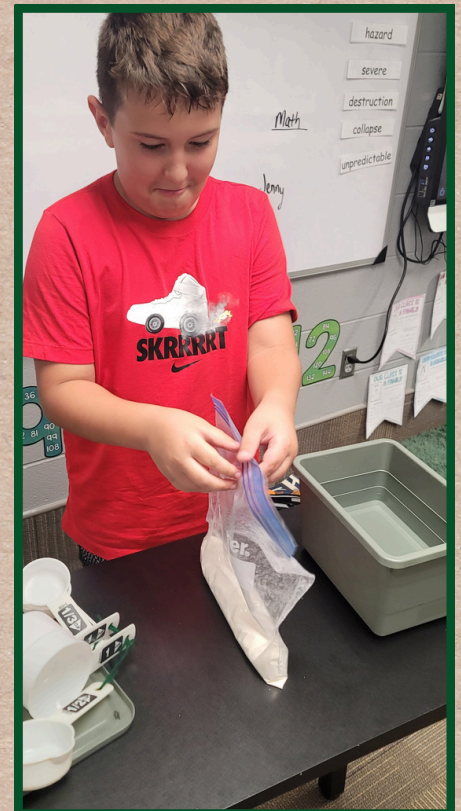
The fourth-grade class recently embarked on an exciting journey to discover how glaciers shaped the state of Indiana. Through hands-on learning, the students explored the three distinct regions of Indiana: the Central Till Plains, the Northern Moraine and Lakes, and the Southern Lowlands.

One of the highlights of our lesson was creating salt dough models of Indiana. Each student crafted their own version of the state, shaping the dough to represent the different landscapes. After allowing the dough to dry, the students eagerly painted their models, bringing Indiana's geography to life with vibrant colors.

In fourth grade, we dive deep into Indiana's history, geography, and the people who helped shape our state. Projects like this help the students connect with our state's past in a fun and memorable way.



4TH GRADE



This week in 3rd grade, our cadet teacher, Miss Kylee, led us through an exciting science experiment that had everyone on their feet literally! The students were divided into groups and each group received a jar. Miss Kylee then guided the class as they added popcorn kernels, baking soda, and vinegar into the jars. And just like magic, the popcorn kernels started to dance!

The class was amazed to see the kernels jumping up and down in the jars. This fun experiment was not just entertaining, but also a great way to learn about the chemical reaction between baking soda and vinegar, which creates carbon dioxide gas. The bubbles of gas attach to the kernels, causing them to rise to the top, then sink back down when the bubbles pop—creating a delightful "dancing" effect. The room was filled with laughter and curiosity as the students watched their creations come to life. Everyone had such a great time, and it was a fun way to see science in action. Thank you, Miss Kylee, for such a fun and engaging lesson.
