What an interesting week- and we are LOVING the great weather we are having. Not too hot- not too cold- the weather is JUST RIGHT!

In science we are learning about lightning and where it comes from. Students learn that lightning is a dramatic example of static electricity. Lightning is a giant spark of energy. It can happen inside clouds or between clouds. You can also see it happen between the cloud and the ground. The shock you sometimes get when you touch metal is also an example of static electricity. Electricity isn't just in your home when you turn on a switch!

And in social studies we are learning about people who have contributed great things in our society. The people we are studying are the Wright brothers, Amelia Earhart, Harriet Tubman, Jackie Robinson, and Lewis and Clark. Lewis and Clark had such a fantastic journey going from one side of the United States to the Pacific coast. What an example of tenacity, exploration and curiosity all built together! Did you know that it took them a year and six months to get out to the Pacific Ocean and six months to get back! Overall it took them two years and four months to complete their journey – which changed the course of America! What an adventure!

In math, kindergarten is sorting and classifying and understanding picture graphs and how to use them. In first grade they are continuing to understand and draw different shapes and understanding composite shapes. Second grade is continuing to learn about telling time; using it in word problems and understanding the difference between a.m. and p.m. In third grade, they are continuing to add and subtract money whether it's a straight addition or subtraction problem or as a word problem Next they will start a unit on telling time. This is more of an overview because they're pretty fluent at telling time!

In language arts, kindergarten is learning about prefixes and suffixes and how thankful is related to thank, how hopeful is related to hope and how reheat is related to heat! In first grade they are continuing with adjectives and how to add *er*, or *est* to change a word. They are also starting on inflected endings *ed* and *ing*. In second grade, they are learning how to correctly spell and use plural nouns with *es* or *ies* and which to use. In third grade they are learning about subjects and object pronouns, comparative adjectives and comparative adverbs. When do you use *er* or *est* or *ly*? The English language is amazing and so full of interesting things to learn! Students are loving their art project in clubs. You would be amazed at the beauty we can create with a melted crayon!

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
