You already qualify for a paraprofessional endorsement!

REQUIREMENTS

- Same as a short term substitute
- Minimum of 60 hours of coursework

HOW TO APPLY

- Log-in to ELIS
- From the Action Center, apply for a paraprofessional license
- Complete application and pay fee

EMPLOYMENT

- Valid for five years
- Renewable
- Eligible to be employed as a paraprofessional full-time
- No limit on work days
