The month is flying by quickly. I will be glad when we can get people in a couple positions to help ease the strain. We will look to interview for the facility manager position hopefully soon. I want to advertise a little longer to see if we get any more applicants. Deanne, Deb and Holly are doing a good job of holding down the fort in the absence of a facility manager position. They have been doing this long enough that they can organize themselves and get things accomplished.

The gym floor is scheduled to be refinished on July 13-14th. They are coming in on the weekend and finishing it. It fits into their schedule of surrounding schools that they are working on this summer. The stage is something we will need to discuss. The estimate to sand and finish it came in just under \$11,000. The building committee will need to meet and try and decide if that is a good use of our budget or if we can wait another year and see if we can pass a building fund levy. We need to order replacement flooring and decide if we are going to install it ourselves or pay to have someone install.

I think it was a good and informative time to get him up to speed with some of our data and how to access things.
