Gifted & Talented Program

Pine Bluff School District offers a generous Gifted & Talented (GT) Program, currently serving 298 GT identified students in grades 1-12. The program offers 12 Honors courses and 10 AP courses between four schools. Although there are no AP concurrent credit courses offered, there are 4 concurrent credit courses offered in Health Science and Criminal Justice. Of the 241 AP exams given in the spring of 2022, 203 received a score of 1, 30 received a score of 2 and 8 received a score of 3.

PBSD students are provided gifted services in the following ways:



- GT enrichment is provided to all Kindergarten students
- Pull-out program for grades 1-6
- Honors courses in ELA, Science, Math, and Social Studies/History for grades 7-11
- AP courses in Language/Literature, Science, Math, and Social Studies/History for grades 10-12
