Dear Parishioners,

This weekend, we are past the half-way mark of our Lenten journey. As we begin the last final push, we can take stock of where we are. Are we growing in holiness, or sliding into sin? Are we drawing closer to the Lord or further away? We can adjust our plans appropriately.

Last weekend, I shared a verbal update from the St. Edward Pastoral Council Meeting that was held on March 18. We have signed the contracts and made the down payment for the painting, pews, and flooring, as well as the contract for the liturgical furniture. The colors of the walls and ceiling may change from what is depicted in the printout by the elevator.

We are also looking at having the seal of St. Edward placed in the floor. We also talked about the need to either repair the kneelers or replace them, and it was determined to have them examined to see if repairs would be sufficient.

Again, we will begin renovation after the end of school, with a goal to be done mid-August. During that time, we will have an evening Mass on Saturday at St. Eloi, the 8:30 am Mass at St. Edward in the basement. Funerals will have to be at St. Eloi but the luncheons at St. Edward. Liturgical ministers will be volunteers, with (hopefully) servers coming from St. Edward for the Saturday evening Mass.

Next Thursday, April 4, is the Chrism Mass, which will be held at St. Aloysius in Olivia at 7 pm. All are welcome to attend. It is during this Mass that the oils used in our Sacraments are blessed and consecrated.

The Oil of Catechumens (or Saints, sometimes) is used before Baptism to prepare one for the Baptism. The Oil of the Infirm is the oil used in the Anointing of the Sick. The Sacred Chrism is used after Baptism as a seal begun and completed in Confirmation, and Chrism is used during the ordination of priests and bishops (a priest's hands and the bishop's head), as well as the consecration of Altars and Churches. It is also during the Chrism Mass that priests renew their promises.

This Chrism Mass is very much connected to Holy Thursday and the celebration of the Lord's Supper. I encourage all to attend. It is there that the Diocese is most visible.

LENTEN MESSAGE FROM POPE FRANCIS

On the virtue of hope, Pope Francis quoted the Catechism of the Catholic Church, which calls hope the "sure and steadfast anchor of the soul."

"Thanks to God's love in Jesus Christ, we are sustained in the hope that does not disappoint," the pope said, adding that hope "moves the Church to pray for 'everyone to be saved' (1 Tm 2:4) and to look forward to her being united with Christ, her bridegroom, in the glory of heaven."

He recalled a prayer of St. Teresa of Ávila, to "hope, O my soul, hope. You know neither the day nor the hour. Watch carefully, for everything passes quickly, even though your impatience makes doubtful what is certain, and turns a very short time into a long one."

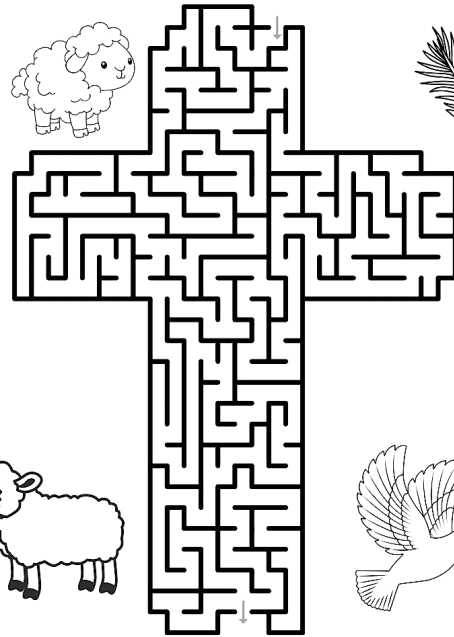

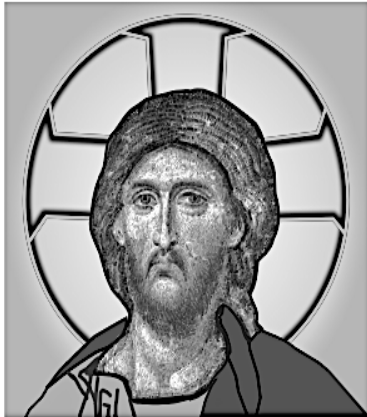
