Although the season wasn't successful as we had hoped, we did spoil the Winter Haven Blue Devils Homecoming with a 7-7 tie.



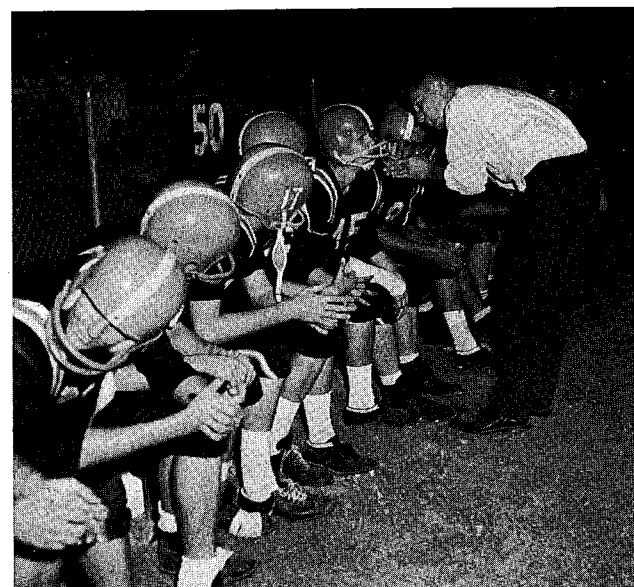
