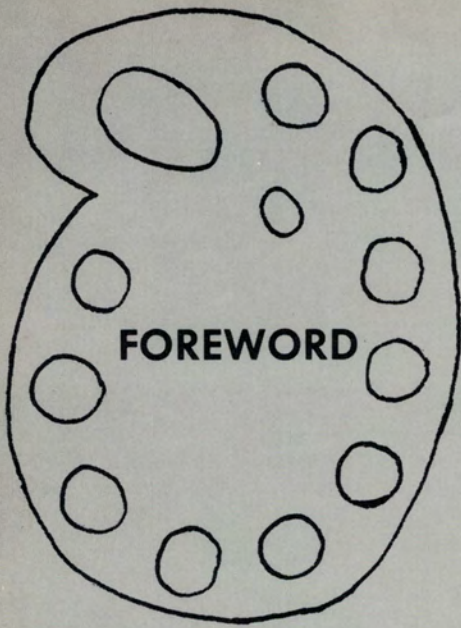

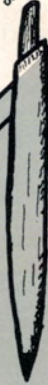


**FOREWORD**

Bunkie Hill -

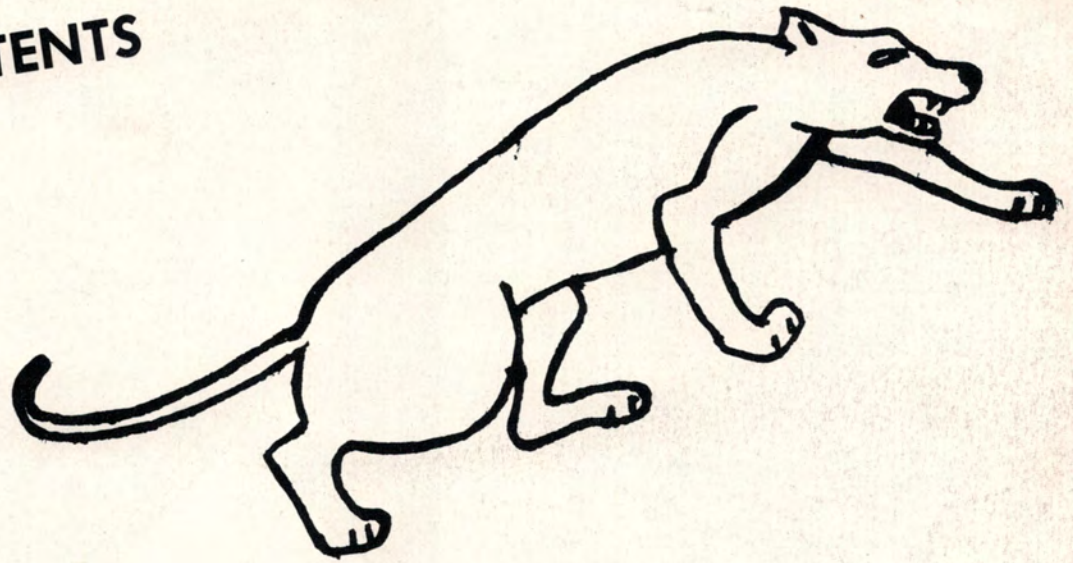

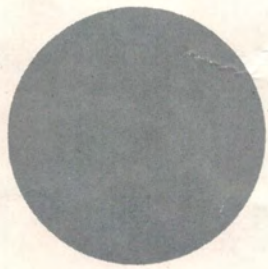
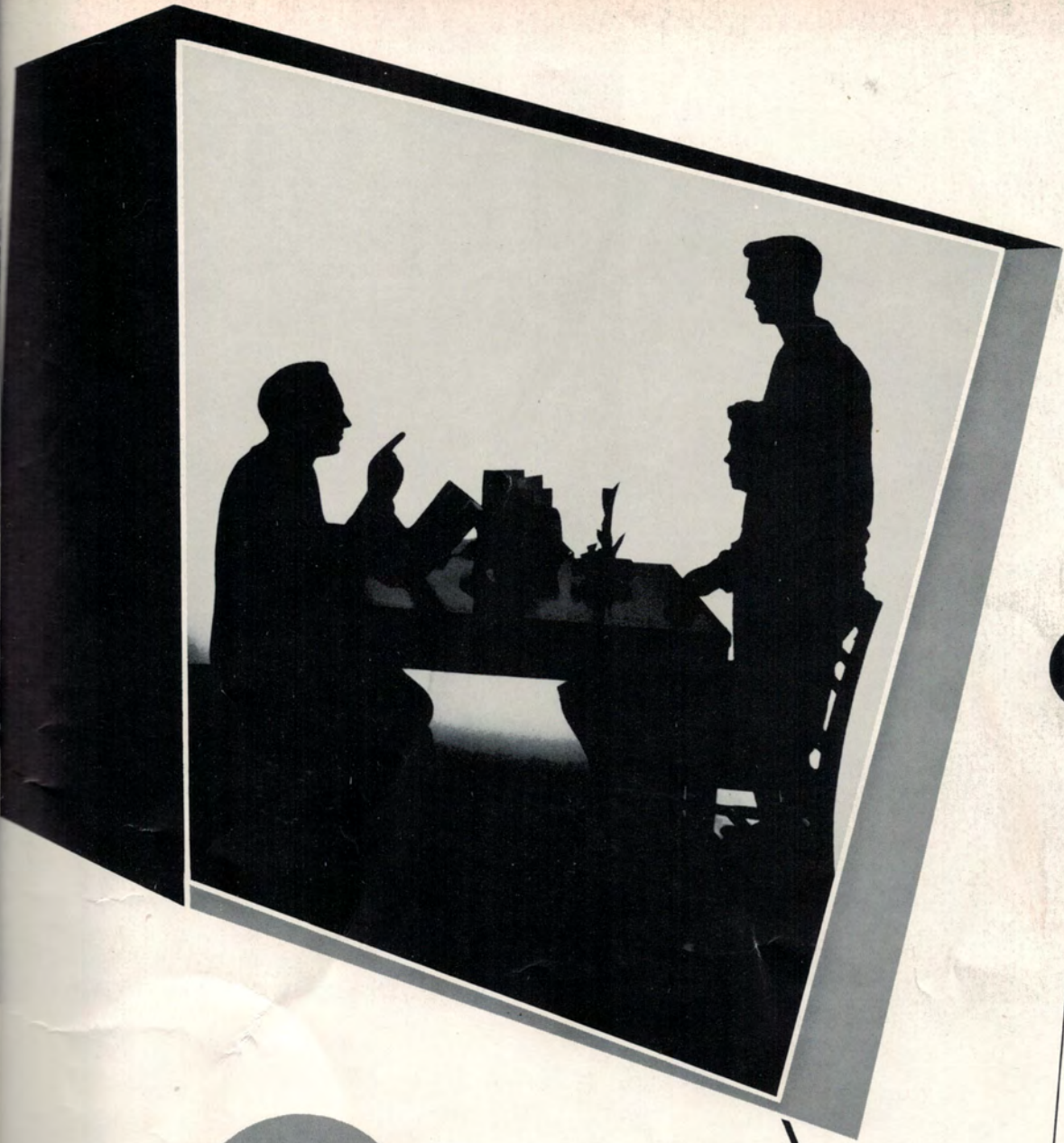
All the students of Bunkie High School now and in all the years to come, we dedicate our 1958 Bunavola.

IN MEMORIAM TO OUR BELOVED SUPERINTENDENT ---

On January 19, 1958, the Great Teacher in his infinite wisdom, saw fit to call our friend and leader, Mr. Louis A. Cayer, to his eternal rest.

Born March 18, 1900, the son of the late Louis A. and Alice Saucier Cayer, Superintendent Cayer completed his secondary education in Avoyelles Parish, received his undergraduate training at Louisiana College, and his graduate training at Louisiana State University.
