Students that meet or exceed their growth or mean score will receive a prize.

POLICY REVIEW

Mrs. Owen presented the Grading Policy for the 2nd reading. The only thing that was added was to drop the lowest grade in every subject each 9 weeks. A motion was made and passed by consensus to accept the Grading Policy as presented. Motion carries.

CSIP - Mrs. Owen went over progress proficiency with the council. Our objective is to go from 45% to 54.7% or above in Reading. 46 to 64% in Math; 31 to 40% in Science, and 33 to 50% in Writing. Goal for achievement gap for students with disabilities. Will reduce the percentage of students with disabilities scoring novice in reading from 66% to 56%.
