

2023 Summer EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES for RCHS Students



Terrific Thursday Day Camp

Who can be hired: Current 7th - 12th graders

- Counselors in Training = Current 7th graders and 8th graders with no work experience
- Counselors = Current 8th - 12th graders
- Lead Counselors = Current 8th - 12th graders (must have lots of leadership experience)

What: Campers of the Terrific Thursday Day Camp will mostly be RCES summer school students. Campers will be divided into age-appropriate groups and will spend the morning participating in workshops. Afternoons will be spent swimming. CITs and Counselors will be expected to supervise the campers, lead activities, and participate in all activities, helping when and wherever they are needed. Busing, lunches, snacks, and program supplies will be provided.

When: Every Thursday in June (June 8, 15, 22 and 29), 9am - 3pm

Where: Graves Mountain Lodge.

How to apply: 7th - 12th grade students should complete the online interest form, which was emailed to them on January 19, 2023. An application will then be sent to interested students by Feb. 1. Students who are hired to work with this camp will participate in a counselor training program on May 22 at Graves Mountain Lodge.

Stipend:

Counselors in Training - \$25/day = \$100 total

Counselors - \$50/day = \$200 total

Lead Counselors - \$60/day = \$240 total

Pathways Academy

Who can participate: Sophomores - Seniors. We want students who are interested in various future pathways to participate in this program. We will accept a variety of students interested in following different paths post high school: 4 year college, a 2 year college, trade school, or going into the workforce. **Only 21 students will be selected to participate in the Pathways Academy.**

What: This summer program will provide in-depth opportunities for participants to explore various careers, participate in a shadowing experience, gain advice from successful business professionals, learn financial skills and tools and learn a variety of life skills. This program is designed to be interactive, educational and fun, with students participating in a variety of field trips and hands-on learning activities. Students who participate in this program will earn one Laurel Ridge college credit. Busing, lunches, snacks and program supplies are provided.

When: June 5-7, 12-14, 19-21 and 26-28 from 9am - 3pm each day. A 10 hour shadowing experience will take place in June, outside of the M-W programming hours.

Where: Rapp-Ce in Sperryville, VA

How to apply: Students should complete the short google interest form, which was emailed to them on January 19, 2023. An application will be sent to interested students by Feb. 1. Selected students will be asked to participate in a short interview.

Stipend:

Participants will earn a \$1,000 stipend for participating in this program

Participants will be given \$100 to invest

Participants will be given \$100 to purchase interview clothing

Fun in the Sun Day Camp

Who can be hired: Current 7th - 12th graders

What: CITs and Counselors will be expected to supervise campers, lead activities and workshops, and participate in all activities, helping when and wherever they are needed. Monday - Wednesday campers and Counselors will participate in/lead morning workshops and will swim each afternoon. On Thursdays, students will go on field trips. Busing, snacks, and program supplies will be provided.

When: Monday - Thursday 9am - 3pm

Where: Mondays- Wednesdays, Graves Mountain Lodge. Thursdays, Field trips

How to apply: 7th - 12th grade students should complete the online interest form, which was emailed to them on January 19, 2023. An application will be sent to interested students by Feb. 1. Students who are hired to work with this camp will participate in a counselor training program on May 22 at Graves Mountain Lodge.

Stipend:

Counselors in Training - \$25/day = \$300 total

Counselors - \$50/day = \$600 total

Lead Counselors - \$60/day = \$720 total

RAAC workshop instructor interns will earn an additional \$20 a day, M-W (an additional \$180 in total)

If you participate in all three programs, it is possible for you to earn \$2,360!

****AND**, RCHS students will be able to participate in a Career Expo in April. Some of the jobs will offer flexible scheduling.
