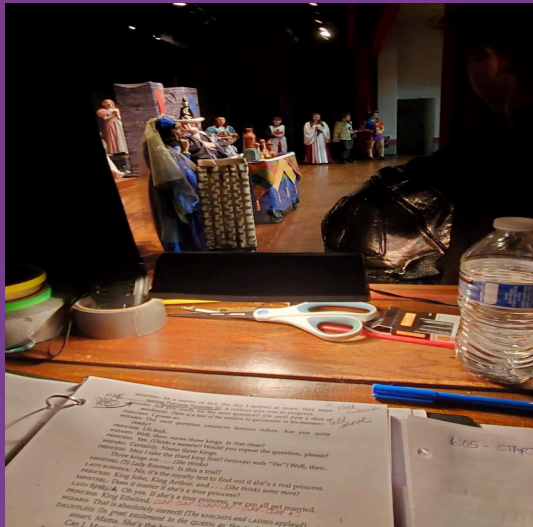


ONCE UPON A MATTRESS

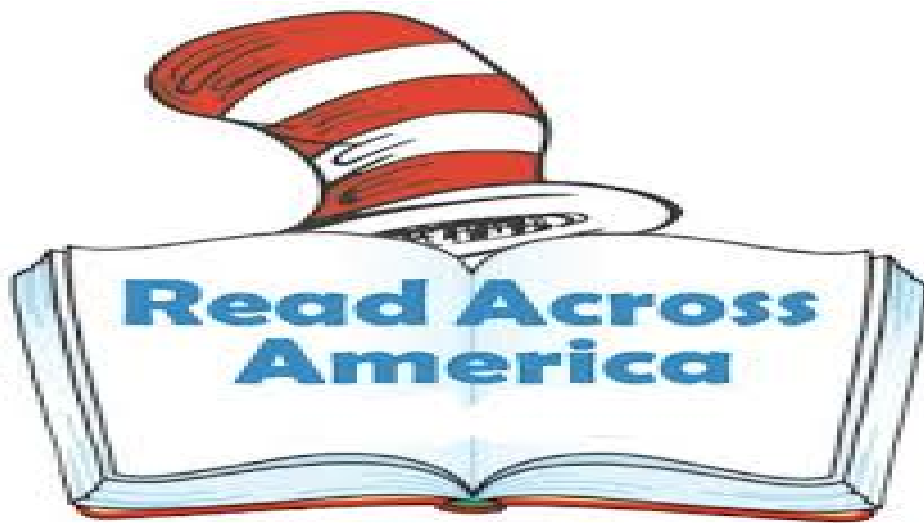
Expedition of A Lifetime

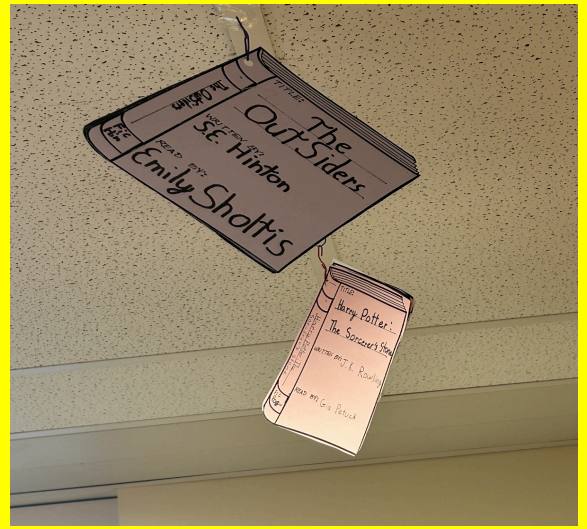
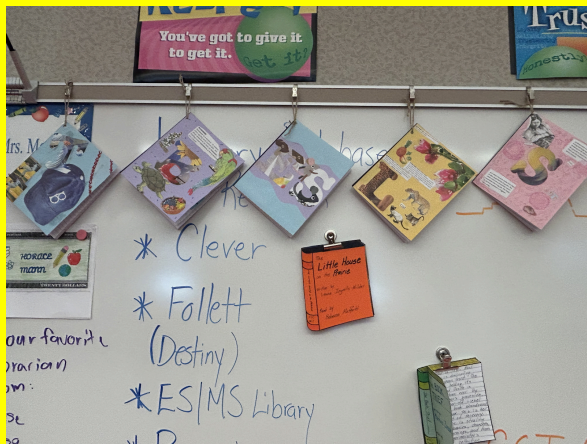
