Franklin County Community School Corporation 2023-2024 School Year

Introduction

Since the onset of COVID-19, Franklin County Community Schools has worked closely with the Franklin County Health Department and the Indiana Department of Health to ensure student and staff safety. This document is designed to provide guidance for the 2023-2024 school year.

Opening Status

Franklin County Community Schools will operate on a normal, in-person schedule for the 2023-2024 school year. Staff will return on Monday, August 7, 2023. Students will return on Wednesday, August 9, 2023.

Face Coverings

Face coverings are **optional** for all students and staff at school and on the bus.

Screening

Students and staff should continue to self-screen before coming to school.

- If you are experiencing symptoms associated with COVID-19, please stay home from school. COVID -19 testing is recommended.
- COVID-19 testing may be provided by the school nurse if testing supplies are available.
- If your child is not feeling well and you have no reason to believe the symptoms are related to COVID-19, simply report your child is not feeling well and keep him or her home until the symptoms improve and your child is fever free for 24 hours.

Vaccinations

- Vaccinations are NOT required for students or staff.

Continuity of Services

- FCCSC will follow all Board approved policies regarding attendance.
- FCCSC will follow all Board approved grading policies and procedures.
- All normal school procedures will be followed.

Tested Positive for COVID-19

- Quarantine for 5 days from the day symptoms started or the date of the positive test.
- If after day 5 you no longer have symptoms or your symptoms are resolving and you have been fever-free for 24 hours without medication, you may return to school on day 6, but will be required to wear a face covering day 6-10.

Contact Tracing and Quarantining

FCCSC will not quarantine students or staff or perform contact tracing.
