




Classroom

Follow grade-level classroom management plan. (Clip chart, DOJO, Ticket Tracker, Point Bank)

Strategies

Redirecting, Modeling/reteaching, Offering choices, Time out, Reminder/Warning, Loss of Privilege, Recess Reflection (5 min.), Student Conference, Parent Contact (through DOJO or phone call)

Minor (PFI)

Chronic classroom behaviors.

**see MINOR Infractions on back

**not including procedural infractions.

1st PFI: Contact Parent via phone to explain PFI procedures, -Enter PFI into IC & print for students to take home for signature and reflection.

2nd PFI: Contact Parent-Enter PFI into IC & print for students to take home for signature and reflection.

-1 day Afterschool Detention

3rd PFI: Contact Parent,-Enter PFI into IC + print for students to take home for signature and reflection.
-2 days Afterschool Detention

4th PFI: Contact Parent,-Enter PFI into IC & print for students to take home for signature and reflection.

-3 days Afterschool Detention

5th PFI: Contact Parent,-Enter PFI into IC & print for students to take home for signature and reflection.

Email Mills that student has reached their 5th PFI.

-Student/Parent Conference with Mills.

6th PFI: Office Referral/ISS *** Any PFI after the 6th follows the 2nd PFI protocol ***

Major (Office/Behavior Referral)

Major offenses that require immediate office referral.

MINOR (PFI) Offenses

MAJOR (Office) Behavior Referra

- Aggressive/Rough Play (rowdy physical play with another student)
- Not keeping hands, feet, and objects to self
- 3. Minor dishonesty (academic-cheating)
- 4. Minor disrespect (Talking back, rolling eyes, non-compliance)
- Classroom disruption (until it becomes severe and persistent frequently).
- Inappropriate Language and Gestures towards other students (name-calling, profanity, inappropriate gestures)
- 7. Excessive talking without permission
- 8. Frequently leaving room without permission
- Chronically not attempting to complete work
- 10. Chronic inappropriate use of technology (playing games, not on correct sites, playing with settings)
- 3 classroom offenses in one day (not including procedural offenses).

- 1. Stealing from a teacher
- Fighting/Physical Aggression (aggressive use of force and/or contact with another person).
- Excessive Defiance (excessive arguing with adults, absolute non-compliance, refusal to follow directly given instructions).
- Verbal aggression (threatening, screaming at, or cursing at people in a hostile, unprovoked manner).
- Extreme disrespect towards teachers/staff (insulting, rude contempt toward adults)
- Sexual comments/actions/behaviors (sexually suggestive remarks, drawings, letters, obscene sounds/noises, etc).
- Bullying (aggressive behaviors in which someone intentionally and repeatedly causes another person injury and discomfort).
- Inappropriate use of technology (inappropriate websites, pictures, or comments)
