Throughout the school year your child will have a book to read at their current reading level in their **Read Every Day** folders. This folder is designed to help you and your child stay organized and prepared.

You and I both want your child to read fluently and their level and comprehend what they are reading. By reading with your child as often as you can, you will promote and practice both of these skills. Your child will greatly benefit from one on one reading time with you, as well as time independently to explore and read books.

Please assist me in this process by reading the included reader with your child each night, asking the questions I have provided in the included sheet, and keep track of progress by signing the reading log each time your child has read.

At the end of each week or once your child is able to fluently read the book to me, I will take the book out and replace it with another book. A book must stay with your child for a minimum of 2 days to build fluency. Please be sure all books and folders are returned daily.

If you find that a book is to difficult for your child, please return it with a note and I will gladly send another.

The goal is for each child to feel encouraged and successful. A little struggle is recommended, but we do not want your child to feel discouraged. Give them a chance to decode words on their own first, but do step in and help if they continually struggle.
