

ACP Courage Against Cancer Scholarship

ACP Courage Against Cancer Scholarship will award three scholarships. All three recipients will be Antonian students of any grade level and the money received will help with Antonian tuition for this school year.

The Antonian Athletic Department began participating in “Pink Out” sporting events in the month of October to raise awareness for breast cancer several years ago. This idea expanded into the “ACP Courage Against Cancer” scholarship to honor and recognize students who have been affected by cancer, whether personally or through a loved one, and provide them with some financial assistance.

Eligible candidates must be in good standing with Antonian and have at least a 3.0 GPA. The student must demonstrate leadership qualities on the Antonian campus and in the community.

To apply, the student must provide a brief (1 – 2 pages, double-spaced) essay describing their story on how cancer has affected them, the activities they are involved in on campus and in the community, and how this scholarship will impact them.
