## SUPPORTING YOUR STUDENT AT HOME

Welcome back to school, students! I hope you all had a relaxing Fall break! We will conclude our 1st 9-weeks at the end of this week. This is a great time to review all the short vowel sounds at home with your child. The 2nd 9-weeks will be focused on going deeper into phonics skills, which includes blends, digraphs, and inflectional endings. Start looking into videos for these skills to give your child a head start!



## OUR LEARNING

**Reading-** I can make inferences. I can use illustrations and details to describe story events. I can compare characters.

**Phonics-** I can read and write words with l-blends. I can read and write words with digraph -ck and double final consonants. I can read and write words with inflectional ending -s.

**Writing:** I can write a narrative text. I can identify articles and demonstratives.

**Math-** I can write numbers 1-50. I can add sums within 20, including with word problems. I can measure objects and compare lengths. I can add 3 addends.

**Science/Social Studies-** I can discuss fire prevention and fire safety.
