- Enrolled as a Lewis County 4-H'er for the last three or more consecutive years and currently enrolled in the Lewis County 4-H Program as a member or leader.
- 2. High school senior or one year post graduation. Extenuating circumstances are evaluated by the Committee on an individual basis when notified by the applicant.
- 3. Enrolled in enough credit hours to be considered a full-time student as stipulated by the institution.
- 4. Scholarship Selection Committee evaluates and approves recipients as merited.
- 5. Scholarship amount is payable to the institution and the recipient after receipt of the Scholarship Payment Form in the WSU Lewis County Extension Office.
- Apply towards tuition, room and board, classroom materials or books/lab only. Disbursement will be as school policy dictates.

- If total amount is not used, remainder must be returned to the Lewis County 4-H Trust.
