

- Parents are welcome to lunch after Labor Day. This gives time for routines and procedures to be established.
- 6. Ensure regular two-way, meaningful communication between family members and school staff, and, to the extent practicable, in a language that family members can understand.**
- Parents may conference with the teacher through a variety of methods: face-to-face meetings, phone conferences, or email dialogue. Parents and/or teachers may request conferences throughout the year as deemed necessary.
 - Teachers will be available to meet with parents during their planning periods.
 - Administrators and counselor will be available to meet with parents at various times throughout the day and after school hours.
 - Use of various social media such as Remind, SeeSaw, and Class DOJO.
 - Class newsletters, homework folders, student folders, and behavior charts sent home daily and weekly to provide academic and behavior information on a timely basis.
 - Notices are sent home for various school events and PTO functions.
 - Parents and/or guardians are notified of invitation to attend Open House, Title I Parent Nights, Awards Day, and other events sponsored by the school.
 - Interpreters will be provided if notice of the need is known beforehand. We will use the District's interpreter website to request translators.
 - Use of online translation programs to translate necessary written correspondence into the language of the parent/guardian.

Parent Responsibilities

We, as parents, will support our children's learning in the following ways:

- Make sure my child attends school regularly and is on time each day.
- Support the school's efforts to maintain proper discipline.
- Monitor my child's academic progress through the use of PowerSchool.
- Participating, as appropriate, in decisions relating to my child's education.
- Be aware of my child's progress by communicating with faculty/staff through participation in conferences, attending meetings, workshops, functions, etc., and reviewing progress reports.
- Serving, to the extent possible, on advisory groups, such as Title I advisory committees and parent and family engagement committees.
