#### DAILY ARRIVAL/DEPARTURE

- Students may be dropped off and picked up at the bridge before and after school.
- School begins at 8:00 AM and ends at 3:00 PM.

- All students must be off campus by 3:15 PM unless involved in a school club or activity.

## ATTENDANCE / TARDIES

- If absent, you must bring a written excuse (to Mr. Gunningham) from a parent within 72 hrs.
- Students have 5 days to make up all work at the convenience of the teacher.

#### Please note the new tardy policy:

- <u>Tardies 1-6:</u> Teacher addressed. Must notify student each time they are tardy and make contact with parent at least once.
- <u>Tardy 7:</u> Administrative Referral entered in Infinite Campus: Student is issued a tardy contract and parent contact is made by administrator.
- <u>Tardies 8-13</u>: Administrative Referral and Administrative Detention will be assigned by administrator.
- <u>Tardy 14 and up:</u> Administrative Referral and ISS assignment by administrator.



#### LOCKERS/TEXTBOOKS/CHROMEBOOKS

- Textbooks will be issued to students as needed.
- Lockers will be issued upon request
- Chromebooks will be issued after a parent signs the electronic device agreement.



#### CREDITS AND PROMOTION

- Need 24 credits to graduate
- ½ credit per class per semester (2 semesters)
- Have potential of receiving 7 credits per year
- Need 5 credits to be a sophomore
- Need 11 credits to be a junior
- Need 17 credits to be a senior
- We don't change grade levels mid-year

## TITLE 9/BULLYING



Nine things you should know about your Title IX rights and your school's Title IX responsibilities

Title IX is a federal civil rights law that prohibits sex discrimination in education.

#### **2** Title IX applies to students of all genders.

Your school must have a clear, well-publicized procedures for responding to complaints of sexual harassment and violence.

Your school must be proactive in ensuring your school is safe for you.

Your school or school district must designate at least one employee as a "Title IX Coordinator." Regardless of the outcome of any investigation, your school may not retaliate against you for filing a complaint.

Your school must respond to violence that occurs "off campus," including on school buses, at extracurricular activities, and online.



Your school must provide you the accommodations you need to stay in school-free of charge.
