### School Environment

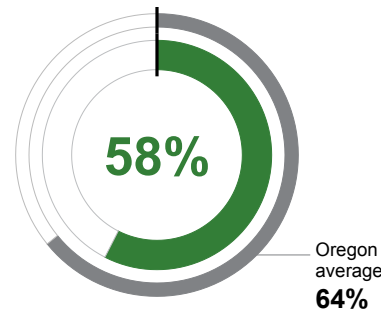
#### CLASS SIZE

#### INDIVIDUAL STUDENT PROGRESS

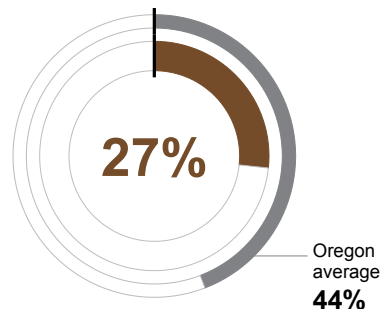
Year-to-year progress in English language arts and mathematics.

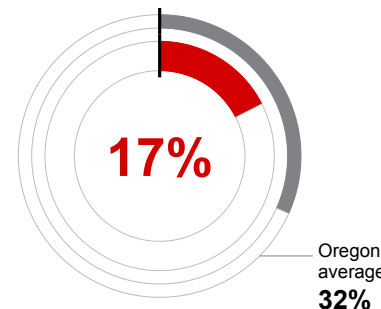
#### ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS

Students meeting state grade-level expectations.



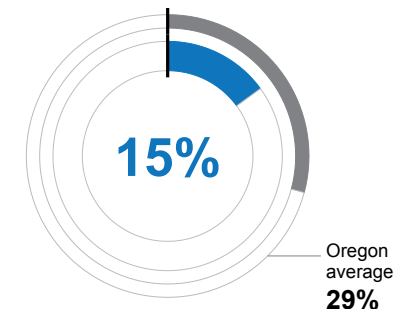
#### MATHEMATICS

### School Goals

Hilda Lahti strives to provide an educational environment that is safe and inviting for all students. For the 2022-23 school year, we are continuing to focus on building respect for all, creating more engaging instruction, and developing targeted interventions. We have a school-wide positive behavior plan for students in all grades. There are three basic expectations: Be Safe, Be Respectful, and Be Responsible. We will implicitly teach the expectations of the building.

### State Goals

The Oregon Department of Education is partnering with school districts and local communities to ensure a 90% on-time, four year graduation rate by 2025. To progress toward this goal, the state will prioritize efforts to improve attendance, provide a well-rounded education, invest in implementing culturally responsive practices, and promote continuous improvement to close opportunity and achievement gaps for historically and currently underserved students.

### Safe & Welcoming Environment

Our school strives to ensure all students and their parents feel welcome. We are implementing sanitizing procedures and protocols recommended by our local health authority. We have a full time nurse who monitors all students. We have a full time counselor for K-8 and share another counselor with the middle/high school. Teachers start their day with a morning meeting and teach social emotional curriculum throughout the year. Every staff member is expected to greet all students and promote respect for all.
