

******Clarification Regarding the Attendance of Children******

Due to limited Seating ALL graduation attendees INCLUDING children, regardless of age, must have a ticket to enter graduation.

The Franklin County School District will have the High School graduation in the High School Auditorium Friday, May 17 at 8:00 p.m. Live stream will be provided in the High School Gym and will be available on the Franklin Advocate website. This decision is FINAL. The guidelines shared yesterday and attached below will be strictly enforced.

1. Each senior will receive 6 stamped tickets to enter the High School Auditorium. You must have one of the stamped tickets to enter the Auditorium. (This will be strictly enforced)
2. Each senior will receive 5 additional tickets without the stamp mentioned above to enter the High School Gymnasium where the graduation ceremony will be projected live on a large screen. You must have one of the tickets without the stamp to enter the Gymnasium. (This will be strictly enforced). Seats will be available on the Home side of the gym and on temporary bleachers on the gym floor.
3. Seating at both locations will be first come- first serve. Saving seats for family members that have not arrived will not be allowed due to the seating capacity of the auditorium and gymnasium.
4. All other family members will have the capability of watching the graduation ceremony live from any location by visiting www.franklinadvocate.com and clicking on the banner at the top of the webpage.

5. Current students that are not graduates must have a ticket to be admitted into either location.
