SENIORS AND FAFSA-If you are planning on attending college in the fall you and your parents will need to fill out the FAFSA form which opens on October 1st. Priority consideration for state programs is given to students whose free application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is received at the federal processor on or before March 1, 2022. <u>Sallie Mae</u> has a tutorial on how to fill it out along with Mrs. Warner and our TRIO Talent representative.

SCHOLARSHIPS...

MASFPS & NAFEPA SCHOLARSHIPS

MASFPS (MICHIGAN ASSOCIATION OF STATE AND FEDERAL PROGRAM SPECIALISTS) SCHOLARSHIP-will award three state scholarships (\$1500, \$1000 and \$500) to eligible high school seniors who are on track to graduate in the spring of 2022. Selections will be based upon the NAFEPA (NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF FEDERAL EDUCATION PROGRAM ADMINISTRATORS) scholarship which will be sponsoring four scholarships each worth \$2500 they are all non-renewable. Two scholarships are for students pursuing degrees in Education. The other two scholarships may be awarded to applicants pursuing degrees in Education or any other field. Stop by the counseling office to pick up a copy or download the application. Deadline to the counseling office is January 5, 2022.

MICHIGAN INTERSCHOLASTIC ATHLETIC ADMINISTRATORS ASSOCIATION (MIAAA)

SCHOLARSHIP-is awarding thirteen \$1000 scholarships honoring top high school male and female student-athletes from each region. If you have a GPA of 3.50-4.00 and have earned a varsity letter in at least two different sports during your high school career you are eligible to apply. Have <u>applications</u> to the counseling by January 24, 2022.
