- 5) School Improvement Update
 - a) Schools received MAP growth data comparing our district elementary schools on the fall administration
 - b) LJPS 1st grade was 4th in Reading Achievement, LJPS 1st grade was 2nd in Math Achievement (n=20)
 - c) LJPS 2nd grade was 5th in Reading Achievement, LJPS 2nd grade was 3rd in Math Achievement (n=20)
 - i) 1ST grade students were in PK or not enrolled in school during FY20 when Covid-19 shut down schools. 2nd grade students were in Kindergarten during FY20 when we shut down. Students then had the option to be in-person or virtual last year during FY21. Numerous students attended private programs last year and returned to LJPS this year.
- 6) At our last meeting we shared the Houston County Schools Collective Commitments that guides the work of the collaborative teams.
 - a) Addressing question #3-How will we respond when some students do not learn it? Response to Interventions and Academic Opportunity Time were discussed.
 - i) In addition, we have begun an after school tutoring program for 1st and 2nd grade students in the areas of Reading and Math to target students who need practice or remediation in specific RIT score bands (content areas) to help close learning loss gaps.
- 7) MAP testing is currently in progress for the Winter administration.
 - a) This administration is being done in small groups over two weeks.
 - b) These results will be used to give additional data to #3, for small group AO organization and to question #4-How will we respond if they already know it? We can create enrichment AO groups.
- 8) Covid-19 protocols are being continued, but we are slowly moving back to some “pre-Covid-19” practices as case numbers have reduced and vaccines are now available for anyone over the age of 5 years old.
