Description	Feeling stuck in conversations? Are you the one arguing for change? Motivational Interviewing (MI) is an evidence-based strategy to support behavior change and is applicable to providing mental health intervention to students as well as working within multidisciplinary teams. This MI training allows participants to develop and enhance their skills in MI as it is applied in the school setting. Participants will review the foundational elements of MI and receive support for the practical application of these skills and knowledge. This training aims to establish a solid foundation for developing fluency in MI, enabling participants to build confidence and proficiency in its use. This live, instructor-led course series consists of a two-day, in-person training.
Prerequisite	This is an intermediate-level training. If do not have prior Motivational Interviewing training, please complete introductory training, such modules provided by Improving MI Practices (https://improvingmipractices.org/courses-and-resources/courses/motivational-interviewing).
