At the July 7, 2022 special meeting that was called for the purpose of holding a student transportation hearing, a panel of the New Milford Board of Education took the following actions:


Mr. Helmus called both the special meeting and the hearing to order at 4:17 p.m., and at 4:18 p.m., Ms. Sarich moved that the Board enter into executive session as personally identifiable information relating to the student who was the subject of the hearing was likely to be discussed, and further moved to invite into executive session all of the named individuals listed above as well as the parent of the student who was the subject of the hearing. Ms. McInerney seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

At 6:13 p.m., the Board returned to public session, and made the following motions:

1. Mr. Helmus moved that the Board of Education adopt the findings of fact and conclusions of law discussed in executive session regarding the student transportation hearing. Ms. Sarich seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
2. Mr. Helmus moved that based upon the factual findings adopted by the Board of Education, the Board find that the student who was the subject of this student transportation hearing is entitled to the school accommodations that the parent has requested on the student's behalf. Ms. McInerney seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
3. Mr. Helmus moved that the Board authorize the Board's procedural advisor to prepare and to issue to the parties the Board's written decision in accordance with the foregoing Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Decision. Ms. Sarich seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Helmus adjourned the hearing and the meeting at 6:15 p.m.
