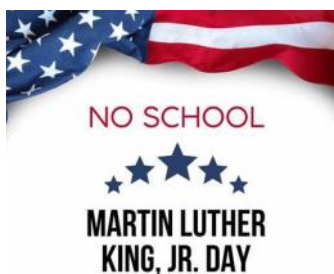

School Notes - Winter Weather Information:

When it comes to the cancellation of school, we will attempt to make that decision as early as possible for everyone's safety and convenience. In making that decision, we will always err on the side of safety for our families. Since the weather can vary greatly across the Saxony attendance area, if we have school but you feel it is unsafe for your student to come to school because of weather related road conditions, please keep them at home. Just call the office to let us know and the absence will not be counted against your student. The safety of all of our students and families is a top priority for Saxony. If we cancel school, it will be announced through the various media outlets in our area. We encourage you to sign up for notifications from KFVS12. We will send information through PlusPortals and via our **Saxony Lutheran App** as well. **If you have not done so, please download our app to receive the most up-to-date information as quickly as possible.** Weather conditions could also be such that we would have a delayed start or early dismissal. If we have a delayed start, it will be a two hour delay and school will begin at 9:50 a.m. with homeroom. With an early dismissal, we will make every effort to make that decision in a timely manner that allows for the safe transportation home for everyone.

In the event of a long term weather issue, we will implement an E-Learning Day schedule. That information is located on the next page.

Student Expectations for Crusader E-Learning Days

1. The expectation of Crusader E-Learning Days is that it will be valuable and move the class forward by one day, just as if we were in school! It is an expectation of all students to join each class via Teams. Each class period will last 15 or 30 minutes depending on the E-Learning Day, and attendance will be taken.

2. The school day will last from 9:00 a.m. – 11:45 a.m. with a BLUE DAY, GOLD DAY, or WHITE DAY schedule as follows. Communication via email will give the students directions if the Crusader E-Learning Days are a BLUE, GOLD, or WHITE DAY.

BLUE DAY

1st period = 9:00 – 9:30
2nd period = 9:45 – 10:15

3. Teachers will be engaged with the students during these set times for Crusader E-Learning Days. Class instruction, activities, discussion, and/or assignments will be communicated on Teams during your scheduled class time. Teachers will inform and guide the students on how their class period will function as we work together to create a great learning environment and conduct class in a creative way.

4. As a student, you are expected to join via Teams for each class period and complete all course activities and assignments as instructed by your teacher. All completed assignments need to be submitted by the deadline assigned.

- Teams Etiquette
 - Join and be ready for class at the scheduled time.
 - Be dressed appropriately.
 - Find a good working space where you can sit and be ready for class.
 - Make sure your face is visible during the class, so your teacher knows that you are actively participating.

5. Academic honesty is one of the most important characteristics of a good school, and we expect all students to maintain high standards in all academic settings, including E-Learning. All work completed must be your own. You are not to copy, borrow, share work, or collaborate with other students unless the teacher has instructed you to do so. You may not use the internet, or any other sources (including people) not specifically approved by the teacher to complete your assignments. If you are unsure about what academic honesty means for an assignment, check with the teacher.

6. Students, you can contact your teachers via email anytime! To find a teacher's email, log into your email account and search the app "People" OR start a new email message, and click in the "TO" textbox, type the last name of your teacher, and select the correct name in the drop down. Make sure to send proper and respectful emails to contact your teacher. Expect responses from your teachers during normal school hours.

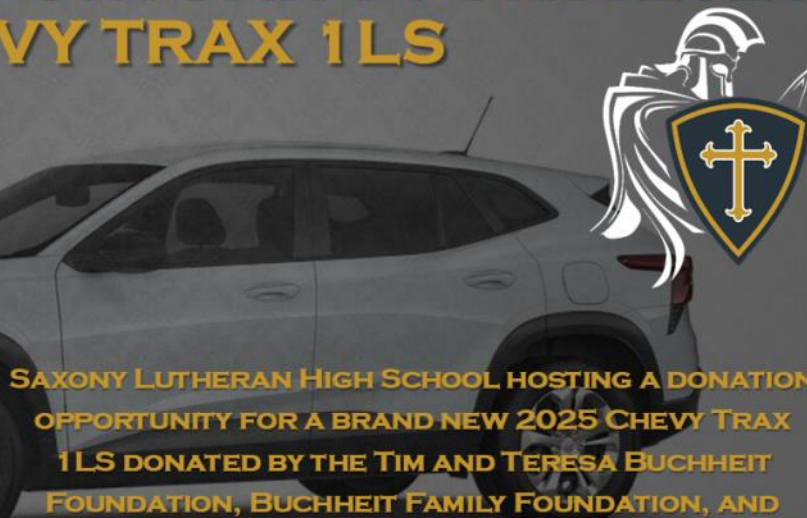

From the desk of Mrs. Kiehne:

Seniors - The FAFSA is now open! The 2025-26 FAFSA is open and you may login, work on, and submit your FAFSA now. If you try to log in and cannot get in, just try again another day. The priority deadline to submit your FAFSA for entering college in the fall of 2025 is **February 1st, 2025**.

If you were unable to attend the *Financial Aid/Scholarship and FAFSA Presentation on December 16th*, information will be forwarded to senior students and parents as a follow-up. Watch for an email from me.

What is the FAFSA? If your student is planning any form of education after high school, they must complete (with your help) the **Free Application for Student Aid**. The website to visit is studentaid.gov. Each senior had the opportunity to set up their FSA ID during our Senior Meeting on October 17th. They should have saved their login information. One parent or caregiver, and possibly more this year, will also need an FSA ID. For example, if your family has a parent living in another household, that parent will also need an FSA ID. If you have an older child in college, you use the same FSA ID that you've signed in with previously. Once the login credentials are set-up, it takes a few days for the government to validate that you are a real person and that all of your identification numbers match (Social Security number, birthdate, etc.).

What about next year for grades 9-11? Every January/February, we begin planning for the following Academic Year and reviewing our Four-Year Plans. We typically do this in Crusader Time set aside in January and February so that course selections can be completed by early March. I will also visit Language Arts 1, 2, and 3 classes to review graduation requirements, courses that are available next year and beyond, and so that I can answer any specific questions they have. Course selections will be made electronically on the students' Plus Portals accounts and will be due to be completed in early March 2025.

What do juniors need to know for course selection and senior year? Each junior and their parents will meet with me individually during January and February for "Junior Meetings." These meetings allow me to talk with students about their post-high school plans and assist individually with course selection. This helps to align students' course selections to post-high school plans. We also review the timeline of activities for senior year.

What happens next? After course selections are submitted, all selections are reviewed and the administration determines which courses will be offered the following school year. Changes are made to course selections based on course sizes, student preparedness for courses, teacher recommendations, and other factors. Updated course selection reports are sent to students and families over the summer with the second semester report card. Please review these carefully. It is very difficult to make changes to selections after the end of May because over the summer, the school master schedule is created. Students receive their school schedules in early August.

What about the sophomore visit to CTC? Every January I take the sophomores to visit either the *Cape Girardeau or Perryville Career and Technology Centers* for a tour and information session. This year, our visit is scheduled for **Tuesday, January 14th**. Cape Girardeau and surrounding county (Scott) resident students will visit Cape CTC in the morning prior to lunch and the Perry County students will visit after lunch. More information with a permission form and specific times/information will be forthcoming after Christmas.

How do I register for my SEMO dual credit courses for Spring Semester? In order to sign up for spring dual credit courses at SEMO, students will need to log into their semo.dualenroll.com/login account and choose the courses they would like to register for. If the student does not have an account, they will need to click the button on the right side of the page to create an account using an email address and password. You may use your Saxony email address for this, or you may prefer to use a personal email address such as a Gmail account. I sent instructions and course availability in a separate email to students and parents. Payment must be completed by the student in their MySEMO account by February 3, 2025.
