

## **Ezzell ISD ESSER III Plan 2021-2023**

Ezzell ISD will apply to receive \$158,257 in Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief III (ESSER III) funds.

- 20% of the ESSER III funds must be reserved to address the academic impact of loss of instructional time through the implementation of evidenced-based interventions. Ezzell ISD has reserved \$31,652 to address learning loss of our students.
- The Ezzell Return to School plan that was created last summer was revised this summer will serve as the required Return to In-Person Instruction and Continuity of Services (RIPICS) Plan- to be reviewed every 6 months with stakeholder input
- Ezzell ISD has built targeted intervention time into the master schedule and will provide before and after school tutoring and summer school to meet the needs of our students
- Ezzell ISD will provide evidence based intervention programs and intervention personnel to address the learning loss of special populations identified in the needs assessment.
