## SUPPORTING YOUR STUDENT AT HOME

Students should be reading daily at home with parents, grandparents, siblings, or stuffed animals even! While your child is reading, ask probing questions about the text and about what they're thinking. Extend their reading by having them write about the story or even how they think the story should have ended. Rereading a story also builds fluency and automaticity, so if they want to read it again and again, feel free to let them!



## OUR LEARNING

Reading- Identifying who is telling the story; ask and answer questions about a story

Phonics- 3-letter blends; plural words; closed syllables

Writing: Composing a complete sentence independently; opinion writing; commas and adjectives

Math- Addition and subtraction within 20 using strategies; 2-d shapes; 3-d shapes; using the equal sign

Science/Social Studies- Famous Historical Figures
