# Schedule

If your child is eating breakfast, please arrive at 7:30. Students will not be allowed in the classroom until 7:45. They will stay in the cafeteria until 7:45. Breakfast ends promptly at 8:00 a.m. The tardy bell rings at 8:10. Please be on time and prepared each day.

# Communication and Homework

- Please subscribe to Remind or Dojo with the code your teacher sent home.
- Please initial daily folders.
- Homework is sent home Monday through Thursday and must be turned in each day. Homework should be completed by the student independently.

# Uniforms

- You may find the uniform policy in the Parent & Student Handbook that is on the Council Website. Please make sure students are in proper uniform each day. They should always be in full uniform on Picture and Awards Days. They may wear a Council sweatshirt on Fridays.
- PE Uniforms:
  - PE Uniforms must be the Council Shorts and Council Shirt. Plain red and white may not be worn. Shoes must be all white.

# Grading

- Reading: 3 Major Grades (60%), 3 Minor Grades (30%), 2 Additional Grades (10%)
- Language Arts: 3 Major Grades (60%), 3 Minor Grades (30%), 2 Additional Grades (10%)
- Math: 3 Major Grades (60%), 3 Minor Grades (30%), 2 Additional Grades (10%)
- Social Studies: 3 Major Grades (60%), 3 Minor Grades (40%)
- Science: 3 Major Grades (60%), 3 Minor Grades (40%)
- Social Development: An average of homework completion (40%) and behavior grades (60%).

Students must maintain A's and B's in all subjects, including Conduct/Workstudy to receive A or A/B Honor Roll.

# PE

First graders need to come to school dressed out for PE, since PE times are in the morning. They change into their uniforms after PE.

Please make sure their clothing, shoes, and bags are labeled.

Please try to practice at home with your child things like buttoning shirts, pants, and jumpers as well as tying shoes and tucking in shirts. This will help us maximize our learning time.

# Dismissal
