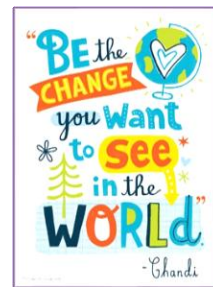

Off to a Great Start! – We are working hard on learning rules, routines, and transitions between classrooms. We have started our first reading unit and becoming familiar with the ALL Block rotation for group and independent practice.

HOMEWORK – Just a reminder that 5th graders have homework EVERY DAY. We correct their DLR (Daily Language Review) each morning in class. They get their DLR homework packet the Friday before it is due. They also need to have a math practice completed each day.

SPELLING – 5th Grade students have a spelling test every Friday, with the exception of short weeks. They get the list on Monday, and we do various practice with the words throughout the week. I encourage students to study and practice their spelling words at home too. Each spelling list focuses on a phonetic or language pattern.
