



Park View PFC Minutes October 12, 2021



1. **Call to order/Introductions/Pledge of Allegiance**

The meeting was called to order at 6:02 p.m. The meeting started with the Pledge of Allegiance.

2. **Approval of Minutes-**

The minutes from the September 14, 2021 meeting were read. A motion was made to approve the minutes. The motion was seconded. The motion passed.

3. **Reports**

- **Principal Report** - Mr. Schuller reported that the 2nd assembly was held in smaller groups. Awards for Cooperation were given. The first outdoor assembly will take place during Red Ribbon Week where all students will be outside. Some classrooms are now equipped with hepa filters. There will be an air test soon to compare those with and those without. The district is working with the county to have Covid testing in town. It might possibly be open to the community and may be located at the high school. The testing site may also provide rapid tests with results in 24 hours. No date is set yet. There have been drawings on Fridays to reward students with gift cards for good behavior. There are plans to train the yard duty staff in order to broaden the Positive Behavior program.
- **Teacher Report** - There was no teacher report.
- **Treasurer Report** - Amber Trask reported that the balance in the general fund is \$142,937.86. The net income from 2021 fundraisers is \$59,844.64. The proposed income for 2021-2022 is 65,052.34. The drive-thru dinner and pie sales projected income is a little higher than last year. The Carl Jr. fundraiser brought in \$645.74.
- **Correspondence** - There was no correspondence.
