Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s):

In order to comply with New Jersey State monitoring procedures, it is important that you be informed of our current <u>disciplinary procedures</u> for Archbishop Damiano School.

Archbishop Damiano School will provide behavioral supports for its students in adherence to the elements of positive programming as outlined in the St. John of God Community Services Behavior Management Manual.

The programming is based on the premise that inappropriate behaviors serve a communicative function. The purpose of positive programming is to determine the communicative intent, decrease inappropriate behaviors while teaching the person a more socially acceptable means for meeting his/her needs.

However, there are times when severe disciplinary problems may occur resulting in the suspension/expulsion of a student. Archbishop Damiano School collaborates with local school districts in these cases and adheres to **N. J. A. C. 6a:14-2.8 policies and procedures.**
