During this time we have had members come and go. Currently we have 4 members, Jimmie Chicarello, Margaret Kernan, Pat Roden and me. Since August of 2011 we have given away more than 2,759 items. The recipients have been: nursing home patients, homeless men, women and children (Firehouse Shelter, First Light, Changed Lives), people who are sick, people who have had surgery, people in the hospital, Covid patients (UAB West), Nurses and Hospital workers (prayer shawls and pocket crosses), cancer patients (chemo hats and prayer shawls), people who have had a loss, Veterans (Birmingham, Tuscaloosa, Pell City), Footprints (NICU babies), over 17 Nursing homes in the area, St. Jude Hospital, Laura Crandall Brown Foundation, Knights of Columbus Coat and Scarf Collections (hats and scarves), Little Sisters of the Poor in Mobile and, Dominican Mother House in Springfield, IL. Many of our prayer shawls have found their way to IN, IL, FL, NY, CA, even England and Ireland, our parish shut-ins and, several hospital Oncology Departments. Sad to say over 94 friends and parishioners who received our prayer shawls have passed away. So you can see why every parishioner plays a big part in our ministry. These people need your prayers. 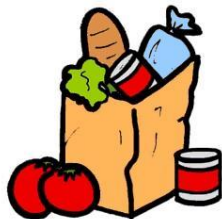
