SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

- Scholarships will be awarded after completion of one semester of post-secondary enrollment
 - Must achieve a minimum of 2.5 GPA
 - Must show proof of enrollment for second semester

SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY

- Must be son, daughter, or under the guardianship of a current GSU member
- Must have a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or higher
- Must have been accepted to a post-secondary institution

- Completed applications must be post-marked no later than April 1, 2022

 - Personal Statement
 - High School Transcript
 - Recommendation by any GSU member or high school teacher
