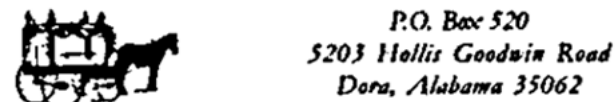

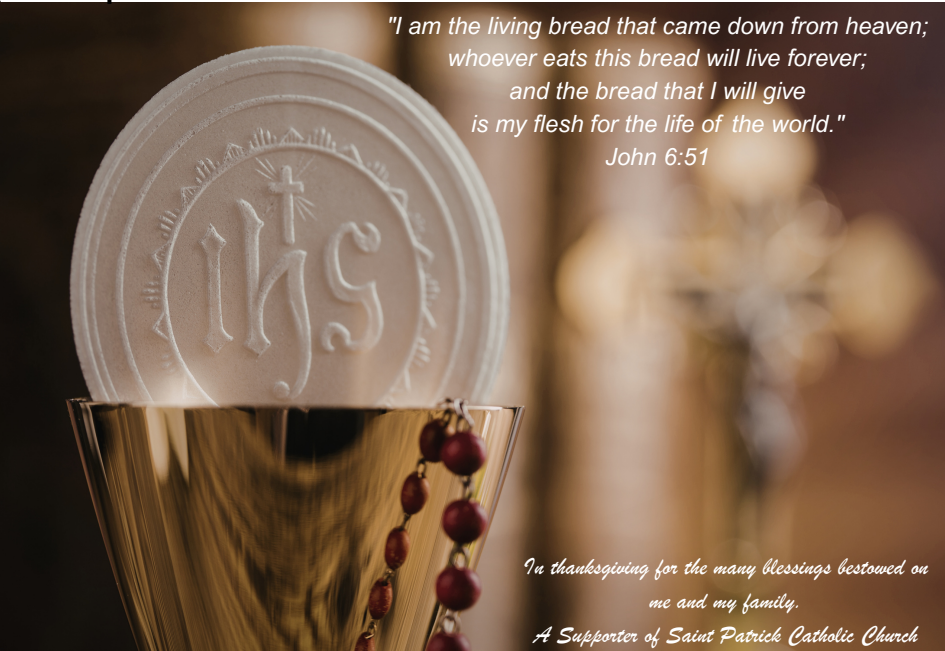


MASS INTENTIONS
