School Responsibilities

2. Hold parent-teacher conferences (at least annually in elementary schools) during which this compact will be discussed as it relates to the individual child's achievement. Specifically, those conferences will be held:

- first semester of each school year

3. Provide parents with frequent reports on their children's progress. Specifically, the school will provide reports as follows:

- Schoology progress reports generated weekly
- quarterly report cards

4. Provide parents reasonable access to staff. Specifically, staff will be available for consultation with parents as follows:

- Staff will be available for scheduled conferences and parent phone calls during daily planning time and at mutually agreed upon times either before or after school

- observes classroom instruction (with visitor or volunteer office log-in on non-testing days) with specific focus on gaining knowledge of research-based instructional strategies to replicate at home

6. Ensure regular two-way, meaningful communication between family members and school staff, and, to the extent practicable, in a language that family members can understand.

- social media and electronic communication (Facebook, Twitter, and ClassDojo)
- (communication can be translated into another language when requested)
