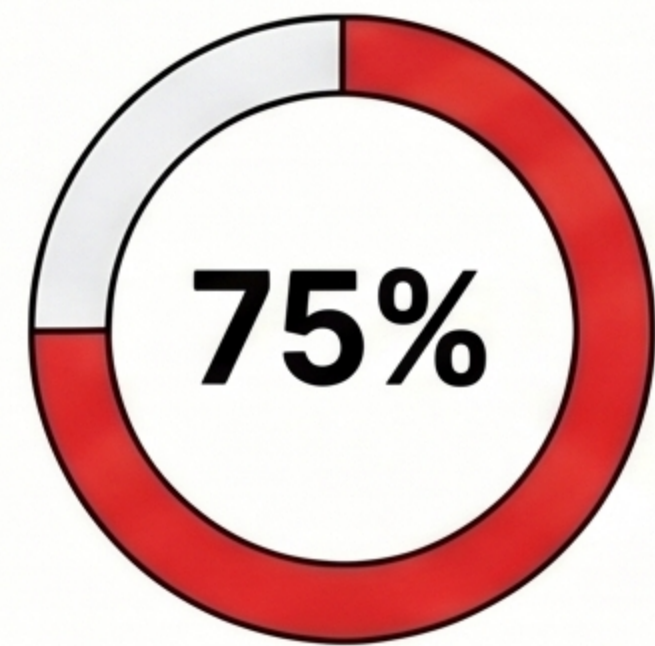


School Community Pulse: 2026 Survey Insights

(The Home Perspective)

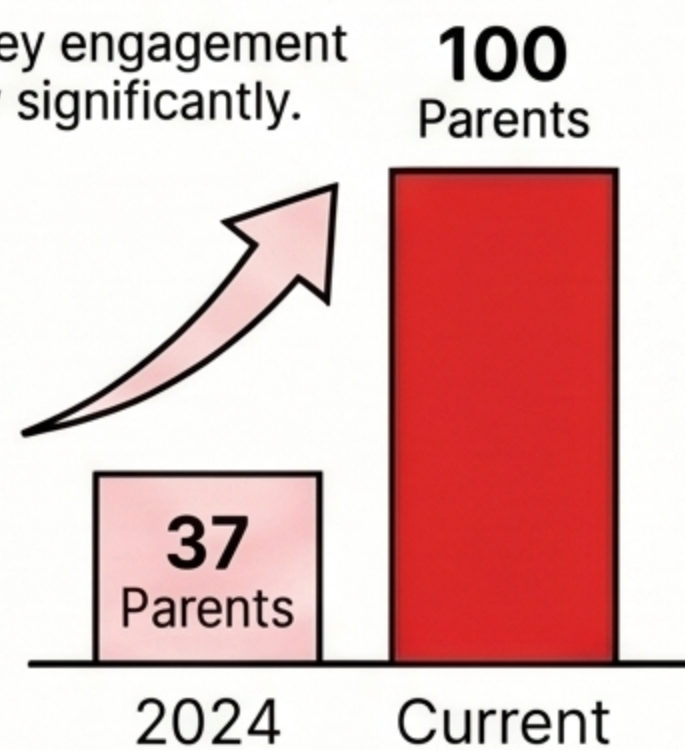


Student Connection Rate

Survey engagement grew significantly.



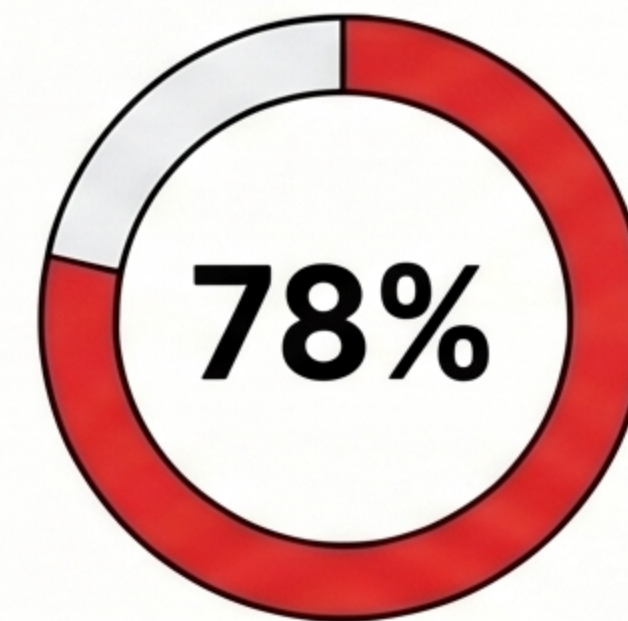
Motivation & Teaching Alignment Gap

(The Classroom Experience)

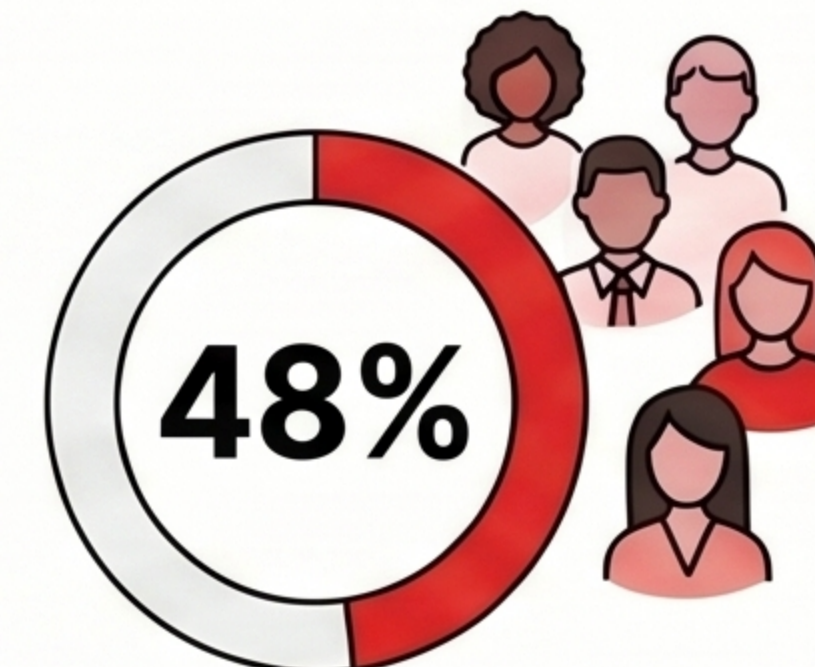


A strong majority of students feel they have a reliable adult mentor.

Identify Diversity Support Gap
