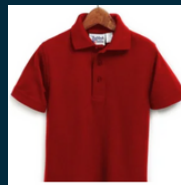




## MANDATORY UNIFORM DRESS POLICY FOR STUDENTS

### Pants, Capris, Skirts, Jumpers, Skorts, or Shorts:

- Khaki uniform style or Griggs school plaid #49 only.
  - \*Skirts, skorts, and shorts must be 3" from the middle of the knee.
  - \* For modesty reasons, shorts are required under skirts or jumpers.
- No cargo pockets, no corduroy, no khaki jeans, no leggings (used as pants), no hip-huggers/low rise pants, no decorative stitching, no decorative buttons, etc.
- Pants are considered jeans if they have brads, decorative stitching, etc., and are not acceptable.
- Pants must be worn at the waist and must be secured with a belt if belt loops are visible.
  - \*Belts are not required for Pre K, K, and 1st.
  - \*Brown or black belts only.
- No logos or emblems are allowed on uniforms.
- No leggings or tights under shorts.
- Leggings or tights may be worn under skirts.
  - \*Only solid navy or white acceptable.
  - \*NO designs.



School Board policy authorized by state law mandates the wearing of uniforms in all public schools in Mobile County. A committee of parents, teachers, paraprofessionals, and the principal has adopted the following as the uniform and dress code for Griggs Elementary School students.

- Please put your child's name in all pieces of clothing.
- Parents of students who are out of uniform will be notified.

### Shirts:

- Plain, solid white or red golf style polo with 2-4 buttons and collar.
- White button down oxford shirts.
- Short or long-sleeves are acceptable.
- Griggs School logo is acceptable.
- Shirts must be long enough to tuck in easily.
- Griggs Spirit Shirts
  - \*Worn on Fridays & field trips ONLY.
- Undershirts
  - \*Only plain, white, navy, or red undershirts are acceptable.
  - \*Long or short sleeve.
  - \*No prints/designs/colors should be visible underneath outer shirt.

### Shoes:

- ONLY tennis shoes (any color) will be allowed.
- The following shoes\*\*\*\* ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE\*\*\*\* boots, dress shoes of any kind, high-top tennis shoes, heelies(with wheels), light-ups.

### Socks:

- Solid white socks ARE REQUIRED.
- Solid opaque white, navy or red tights are acceptable during cold weather months.
  - \* NO DESIGNS.

### Sweater, Sweatshirt, Lightweight

#### Jacket:

- Griggs gray sweatshirts preferred.
- Plain gray, red or navy solid sweatshirts, sweaters, lightweight jackets allowed.
- Plain solid white, navy, or red button cardigan sweaters are acceptable.
- Sweatshirts must be worn over uniform shirt.
- No logos or print other than Griggs School logo is acceptable.
- **NO HOODIES**

### Hats/Caps :

- Hats must be removed when entering the school.
- Hats are not permissible in the classroom, halls, & cafeteria.

### Jewelry:

- Girls/boys may wear one stud earring in each ear lobe only.
- Stud earrings must be smaller than a pencil eraser.
- Large studs, dangling earrings or hoops are not acceptable. No other jewelry is allowed.
- No facial piercings are allowed.

### Makeup:

- No Makeup.
- No Fake Fingernails.
- No Distracting nail polish.
- No Bandanas.
- No Fragrances are allowed.

### Clothing and Bookbags:

- Clothing must be neat and clean with no open holes, rips, or tears.
- Clothing and Bookbags must not contain offensive graphics or words.
- No metal or glass water bottles are allowed on campus. This includes Stanley/Yeti cups.
- **Clear bookbags will be required for the 25-26 school year.**

### Items not Permissible on Campus:

- Cell phones.
- Smart Watches with cellular or texting capability.
- No toys.
  - \*This includes Pokemon, sports, Magic the Gathering, or trading cards.
- No flavor water packets.
- No energy drinks.
- No sodas.
- Only plastic water bottles are allowed; clear preferred.

### Hair:

- Clean and well-groomed with no carvings or color.
- Hair must be the natural hair color and out of the eyes.
- Hairstyles should not be distracting to the student or other classmates.
